**Ref: Petition received at the London Assembly (Plenary) Meeting on 15 January 2014**

Thank you for your letter of 23<sup>rd</sup> January relating to a petition presented by Murad Qureshi calling for Transport for London and the City to install pedestrian traffic lights at the junction of Charterhouse Street and the A201 Farringdon Road/Farringdon Street. The City of London supports the call of the petitioners for pedestrian facilities to be incorporated within the traffic signals at the Farringdon Street/ Charterhouse Street junction.

This junction straddles the administrative areas of Camden, Islington and the City of London. Transport for London is the highway authority for the north/south route and are also the traffic authority for all traffic signals within London. The City of London has lobbied for pedestrian facilities to be included at this junction for many years. In fact this particular signalised junction is the only one within the City of London boundary which does not include significant green man crossing facilities for pedestrians. It is pleasing to note that the current plans being formulated by Transport for London for this junction do include the green man traffic signal features.
